Have you always wanted to display your art, but never had an entire gallery's worth of works to submit? Us too! We are hosting a Community Art Show, "Our Vibrant Community," in the McCain Gallery at Coaldale Public Library which will be shown between July 30 and August 27. Community members are invited to submit 1-2 works in any 2D medium. For pieces requiring the use of our frames, size 11x14 is best to fit in our 16 x 20 frames, but smaller works can also be submitted. For pieces created on canvas or works which have already been framed, all sizes are welcome to submit.

In your submission please include a scan or image of each artwork along with approximate dimensions and whether your work requires one of our frames. Include 1-2 sentences about the artist as well as a draft gallery label (name of work, year made, and medium). Coaldale and county residents of all ages are welcome to enter. Please submit entries by **July 22** at the latest to be considered. The last day for artwork drop off is also July 22 - so please be proactive and submit earlier rather than later! Note that depending on the number of entries, not all works will be chosen.

Email your submission directly to mdemers@coaldalelibrary.ca to be considered. We can't wait to see your art!



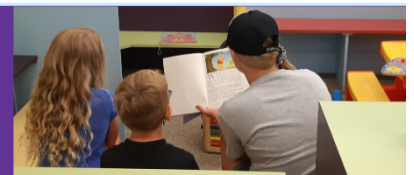

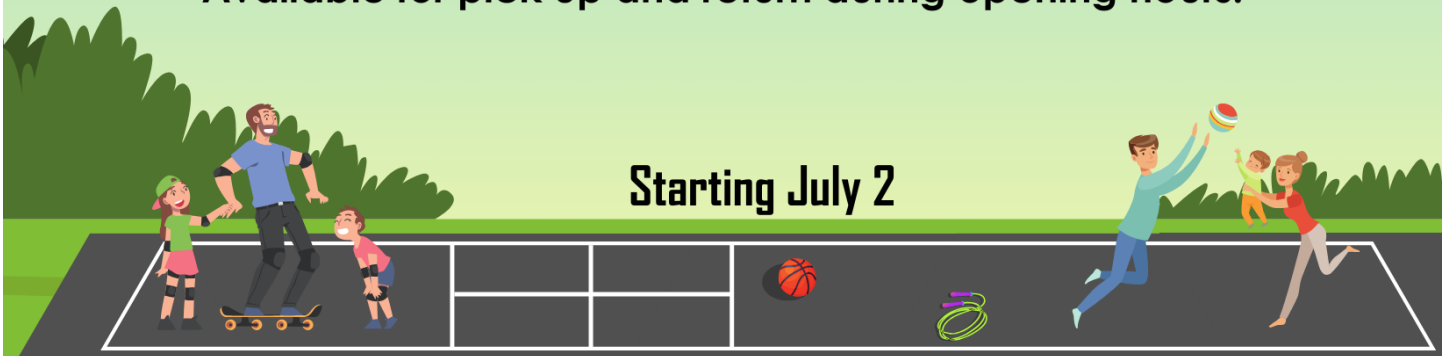

Hello Kim

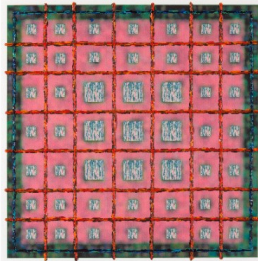
