New! Skate Library

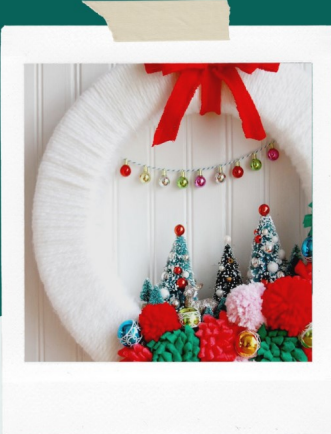
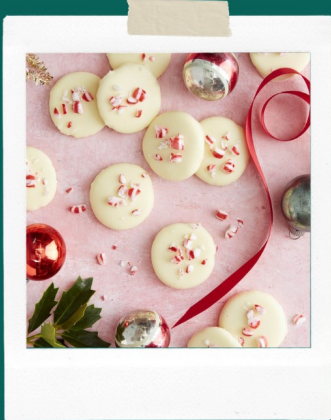
We are now offering skates for rental for **FREE** with your library card!

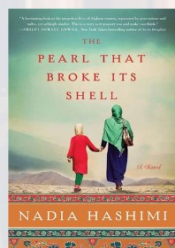


Adult Book Club

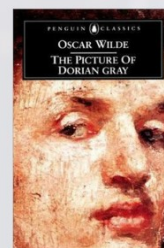
Members read and discuss a variety of current and classic books. Meetings are held the last Monday of each month at 7 pm by the fireplace, with tea and cookies provided.
